May Election: March 17, 2023 (5:00 pm) November Election: September 8, 2023 (5:00 pm)

CANDIDATE WITHDRAWAL DEADLINES (I.C. 34-1405A)

May Election: March 31, 2023 November Election: September 22, 2023

FILING REQUIREMENTS

A candidate must:

- 1. File a Declaration of Candidacy, AND
- 2. File a Petition of Candidacy, containing the required five (5) signatures of qualified electors verified with the County Clerk's Office prior to submission.

ALL CANDIDATES: DECLARATION OF CANDIDACY - FORM EC-1A

When completing the Declaration of Candidacy, be sure to complete all fields and questions. Also, please note:

- 1. For the question, "How you would like your name to appear on the ballot," please clearly print your name exactly as you wish it to appear on the ballot. (I.C. 34-903A)
- 2. You must be registered in the district, and if applicable, the sub-district or zone. (Contact your County Clerk to verify that you are registered in the district, and if applicable, the sub-district or zone.)
- 3. The signature of the candidate must be notarized.

Any incomplete or missing information may void your filing.

NOMINATING PETITIONS - FORM EC-1B (this form may be reproduced)

Candidates for Special District Offices require: 5 signatures of eligible voters within the county (I.C. 34-1404)

All petitions must be complete.

- 1. The top portion of each petition sheet must be filled in prior to circulation.
- 2. The circulator's signature must be notarized on the bottom portion of each petition page prior to being verified by the County Clerk.

CAMPAIGN FINANCE INFORMATION

All candidates for County Office should contact the County Clerk's Office for information on reporting requirements prior to announcing candidacy, accepting donations or spending money.

SPECIAL DISTRICT OFFICE COMPLETING THE DECLARATION OF CANDIDACY

Idaho Code 34-701(2) now requires phone numbers to be provided. Idaho Code 34-704(4) states that all information in declarations of candidacy shall be made publicly available upon request.

SECTION 1: OFFICE INFORMATION

- 1. Enter the name of the office that you will be a candidate for to the right of "Filing for the Office of."
- 2. Enter the name of the District to the right of "District Name."
- 3. Enter the term length and/or the name/number of the sub-district, zone, seat or position to the right of "Term length, sub-district, zone, seat or position (if applicable)."

SECTION 2: CANDIDATE INFORMATION

- 1. Enter your First Name, Middle Initial, Last Name and Suffix, if applicable, as it appears on your voter registration record.
- 2. Enter your Phone Number. Campaign phone numbers are now required and available upon public request. (I.C. 34-701[2], 34-704[4])
- 3. Enter your Mailing Address, including the street number, street name, City, State, Zip Code and County.

SECTION 3: BALLOT NAME

- 1. Enter your Name as it will appear on the ballot. (I.C. 34-903A) (Please print clearly.)
 - a. Nicknames may be included if it is a name that is commonly known. However, nicknames that promote a particular political platform or may be deemed offensive are not allowed.
 - b. Professional identifiers are also not allowed on the ballot (i.e. Dr., M.D., PhD., Esq., CPA, etc.).

SECTION 4: HOMESTEAD EXEMPTION

1. If you or your spouse have claimed a homestead exemption, please list the address in this section. (I.C. 34-107/2], I.C. 34-701/3])

SECTION 5: C-1 CAMPAIGN FINANCE INFORMATION

Pursuant to Section 67-6603, Idaho Code, no contribution shall be received or any expenditure made by or on behalf of a candidate until they appoint a political treasurer. A candidate may appoint himself his own political treasurer.

Pursuant to Section 67-6608(1), Idaho Code, a candidate is exempt from filing reports until such a time as the candidate receives contributions or expends funds in the amount of \$500 or more.

** Any candidate that reaches the \$500 threshold must create a Campaign Finance account through the Secretary of State Campaign Finance Portal.

SECTION 6: CERTIFICATION

- 1. Carefully read the certification.
- 2. Enter the date of the election in the certification.
- 3. In the presence of a notary, sign and date the Declaration of Candidacy.
 - a. The notary will then complete the bottom portion of the Declaration of Candidacy.

WHERE TO BEGIN

Treasurer Appointment & Reporting



Once a candidate has raised or spent \$500, a candidate must file the appointment of a political treasurer

and begin reporting the campaign finances, including the sources and expenses for the first \$500.

The Declaration of Candidacy filed to run for office designates the candidate as the default political treasurer, for those who have not met the \$500 threshold, until an alternate is appointed.

FILING DEADLINES

Objection Disclosures



All campaign material (signs, flyers, mailings, TV ads, etc.) should contain a disclosure statement. For

example: "Paid for Yosemite Sam for Governor, Elmer Fudd Treasurer".



CITIES, SCHOOLS & LOCAL OFFICIALS

REPORTING BASICS

All money raised or spent in relation to a campaign must be accounted for and tracked. This includes the use of the candidate's personal money.

Where to Report

All candidates for all offices now report online via the Secretary of State's Campaign Finance Portal. The portal may be found at https://sos.idaho.gov/elections-division/campaign-finance-filing/

For local officials, all assistance, oversight and enforcement will be done by the County Clerk of the home county for the city, school or local district.



Onation Limits

Maximum contribution is \$1,000 per individual, business* or political committee per election. Any single contribution of \$1,000 must be reported within **48 hours** of receipt.

*Businesses sharing controlling ownership may only contribute \$1,000 combined.



SPECIAL DISTRICT OFFICE COMPLETING THE PETITION OF CANDIDACY

Idaho Code 34-701(2) now requires phone numbers to be provided. Idaho Code 34-704(4) states that all information in declarations of candidacy shall be made publicly available upon request.

SECTION 1: OFFICE INFORMATION

- 1. Enter the name of the office that you will be a candidate for to the right of "Filing for the Office of."
- 2. Enter the name of the District to the right of "District Name."
- 3. Enter the term length and/or the name/number of the sub-district, zone, seat or position to the right of "Term length, sub-district, zone, seat or position (if applicable)."

SECTION 2: CANDIDATE INFORMATION

- 1. Enter your Name as it will appear on the ballot. (I.C. 34-903A) (Please print clearly.)
 - a. Nicknames may be included if it is a name that is commonly known. However, nicknames that promote a particular political platform or may be deemed offensive are not allowed.
 - b. Professional identifiers are also not allowed on the ballot (i.e. Dr., M.D., PhD., Esq., CPA, etc.).

SECTION 3: SIGNERS SECTION

- 2. Enter the date of the election in the Signers Statement.
- 3. Collect signatures of qualified electors (i.e. registered voters) of your district, or if required, your subdistrict or zone.
- 4. Each individual participating in the petition must:
 - a. Sign their name.
 - b. Print their name.
 - c. Print their residence address. (Note: PO Boxes are not allowed. The listing of a PO Box will automatically invalidate the signature and it will not be counted in the number of required signatures.)
 - d. Enter the date that they signed the petition.

SECTION 4: CERTIFICATION

- 1. Enter the County in which the circulator is having the notarization completed to the right of "County of."
- 2. Enter the name of the circulator along with their county of residence in the Certification Statement.
- 3. In the presence of a notary, the circulator will sign and enter their address on the Petition of Candidacy.
 - a. The notary will then complete the bottom portion of the Petition of Candidacy.
 - b. Note: The candidate may have other individuals circulate petitions on their behalf. In this case, the individual circulating the petition will complete, sign and have notarized the Certification prior to returning the completed petition to the candidate.

Upon receipt of the Declaration of Candidacy along with the Petition of Candidacy:

- 1. Verify the qualifications of the Candidate.
- 2. Verify that the Petition of Candidacy is signed by not less than 5 electors and has been certified by the County Clerk's Office.
 - a. If the Petition of Candidacy was not verified by the County Clerk prior to submission to your office, deliver the original petition to the County Clerk's Election Office to have 5 electors verified that they are properly registered electors.
 - b. If the electors are required to be residents of the candidate's sub-district or zone, verify that the electors are in the correct sub-district or zone.
- 3. Stamp or write the date and time of receipt on the front of the Declaration of Candidacy and Petition of Candidacy.
- 4. Complete the fields and statement below.
- 5. Transmit a copy of this Certification along with a copy of the Declaration of Candidacy to the County Clerk for ballot preparation.

- 2. Certification to the County Clerk should occur upon the verification of the candidate's qualifications and the validation of the signers of the petition. To assist the County Clerk in ballot preparation, do not HOLD these until the last day of filing.
