WHEREAS, since 1972, the National Senior Nutrition Program has funded local agencies and organizations to serve home-delivered and congregate meals to help ensure older adults have opportunities to stay healthy, independent, and connected; and

WHEREAS, more than 10 million older Americans face hunger or malnourishment each year; and

WHEREAS, local senior nutrition programs help older adults access nutritious meals, nutrition screening, education and counseling; social opportunities; and various activities amid the company of their peers and neighbors.

WHEREAS, the Idaho Senior Nutrition Program is an integral part of the Twin Falls County community providing sustenance and so much more to our older community members, especially those most vulnerable to food insecurity, social isolation and chronic health conditions; and

WHEREAS, fiscal year 2025 the Idaho Senior Nutrition Program had a positive impact on the community of Twin Falls County and its seniors by:

- Serving 13,574 congregate meals to participants and
- Delivering 38,102 home-delivered meals to participants
