Compliance with Prison Rape Elimination Act (PREA)

History

In October 2012, in response to the Prison Rape Elimination Act, there began a collaborative effort to ensure that the Snake River Juvenile Detention Center would be in compliance with the strict PREA standards. The team consisted of Detention Manager Paul Shepherd, Training Supervisor/PREA Coordinator Brooke Esquibel and Administrative Secretary Peggy Orr. Brook Esquibel has since moved on. Janaan Van Zante took over as the Training/PREA Coordinator in October of 2019.

Today

Over the last ten years, the PREA Team has worked diligently to ensure that Snake River Juvenile Detention Center maintained focus in updating the policies and procedures that are in place to safeguard the juveniles being held in our facility. Although many of the mandated practices were already in place, it became a priority to train our staff to make every effort in preventing, detecting and responding to any incidents of sexual abuse in our facility.

In August, 2016 and August 2019, SRJDC was audited by certified PREA Auditor Steve Jeff of Caldwell, Idaho. Mr. Jett spent 3 days at the facility interviewing staff and residents, and reviewing documents, policies and procedures. Our next audit is scheduled for August of 2022. Once the Final Audit Report is available, it will be posted on this site.
