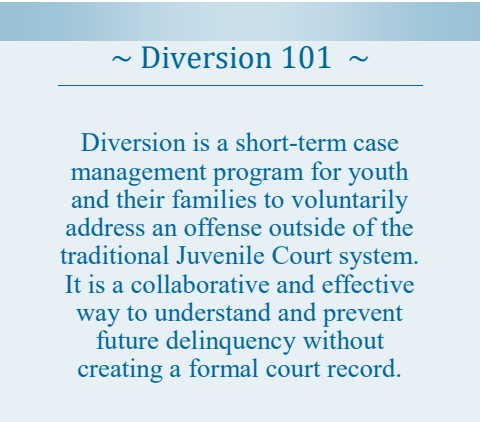
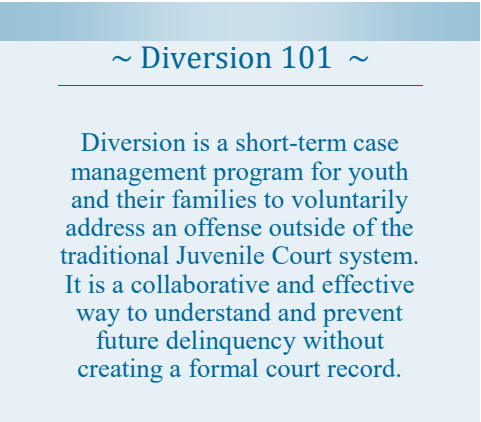

Why do we have volunteer Diversion Boards?

Simply put, the Diversion Program would not be the success it has been in Twin Falls County, if not for our Volunteers!

The Neighborhood Accountability Board (Diversion Board) is a restorative process that brings the juvenile offender, victims, and the community together for more positive outcomes. Our volunteers live and work in the communities they serve. We have Diversion Boards serving all of Twin Falls County. Currently we have seven Diversion Boards in Twin Falls, one in Kimberly, and one in Buhl.

Diversion Boards average two members

Average meetings run between 1 and 3 hours, one Wednesday evening a month

Dinner is provided to our board members on evening of meetings

Training and mentoring is provided by our Diversion Team and Staff members
