SUPPLEMENTAL LEVY ELECTION

SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 414,
TWIN FALLS COUNTY, STATE OF IDAHO

The Board of Trustees of School District No. 414, Twin Falls County, State of Idaho, is seeking authorization to levy a Supplemental Levy for the purpose of funding salaries and benefits not funded from state appropriations for certified and classified staff of the District and its authorized charter school, with all levy funds in the amount of \$800,000 per year allocated to this purpose.

QUESTION: Shall the Board of Trustees of School District No. 414, Twin Falls County, State of Idaho, be authorized and empowered to levy a Supplemental Levy in the amount of Eight Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$800,000) per year for two (2) years, commencing with the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2024 and ending June 30, 2026, for the purposes stated above; all as provided in the Resolution adopted by the Board of Trustees on August 17, 2023.

The estimated average annual cost to the taxpayer on the proposed levy is a tax of \$68 per \$100,000 of taxable assessed value, per year, based on current conditions. The proposed levy replaces an existing levy that expires on June 30, 2024, and that currently costs \$68 per \$100,000 of taxable assessed value. Therefore, if the proposed levy is approved, the tax per \$100,000 of taxable assessed value is not expected to change.
