## Snake River Juvenile Detention Center PREA Report

Report for 2018

The Snake River Juvenile Detention Center continues to place emphasis on the importance of training for staff, medical and mental health staff, volunteers and juveniles in the area of the Prison Rape Elimination Act (PREA). Snake River Juvenile Detention Center has a “Zero Tolerance” policy and approach in all aspects of daily functions. The investigation agency continued to be the Twin Falls City Police Department. Management and staff will always cooperate with any investigations and any accusations under PREA are taken seriously. Information gathered during investigations is used to enhance the safety, security, policies, procedures and training within the facility.

The Snake River Juvenile Detention Center completed its first PREA audit on September 9<sup>th</sup>, 2016. The next PREA audit is scheduled for August 2019 and the auditor again will be Steven G. Jett.

There were no PREA incidents for the year of 2018.
