**SUPPLEMENTAL LEVY ELECTION**

**SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 414,  
TWIN FALLS COUNTY, STATE OF IDAHO**

**March 10, 2020**

QUESTION: Shall the Board of Trustees of School District No. 414, Twin Falls County, State of Idaho, be authorized and empowered to levy a Supplemental Levy in the amount of eight hundred thousand (\$800,000) per year for two (2) years, commencing with the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2020 and ending June 30, 2022, for the purpose of financing any lawful expenses of maintaining and operating the District; all as provided in the Resolution adopted by the Board of Trustees on January 16, 2020?

The estimated average annual cost to the taxpayer on the proposed levy is a tax of \$144 per \$100,000 of taxable assessed value, per year, based on current conditions. The proposed levy will replace the District's existing supplemental levy which currently costs \$45 per \$100,000. The District's Bond Levy will decrease by \$33 per \$100,000, and the District's Emergency Levy which currently costs \$36 per \$100,000 will expire, on July 1, 2020. The net effect to the District's expected overall levy rate, based on current conditions, is a \$30 increase per \$100,000 per year.
