The Board of Community Guardians provides assistance to adult citizens who are no longer able to care for themselves. Wards under our guardianship cannot make or communicate responsible decisions, or provide for basic needs such as food, clothing, health care and safety. Our role is to ensure these vulnerable adults are protected from exploitation, abuse and neglect.

Being a **Volunteer Companion** is incredibly rewarding and a wonderful way to give back to your community. As a volunteer, you will visit a designated ward on a regular basis and act as a second set of eyes and ears for the Board of Community Guardians. You are not the care provider or guardian, but the time you spend with a ward helps us monitor their situation and ensure they are receiving the benefits and care they are entitled to and need.
